



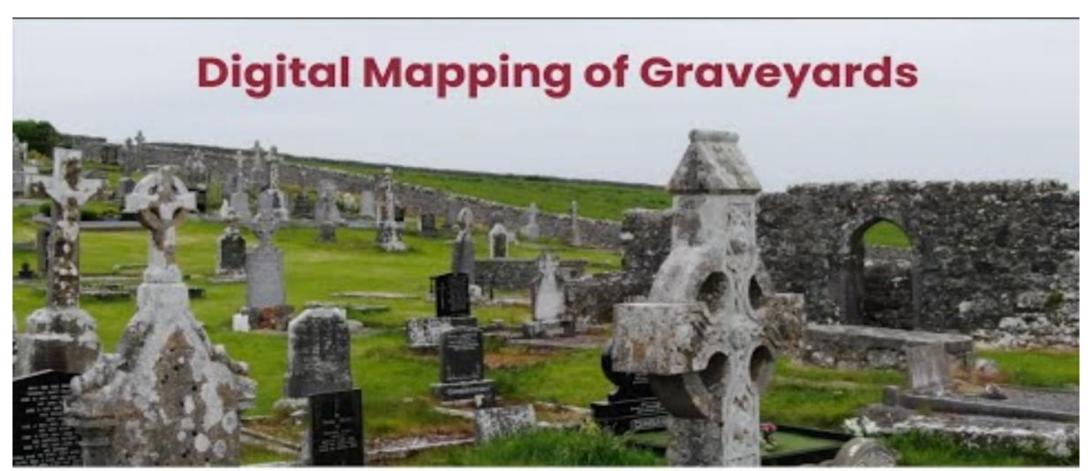
Project Background

- Galway County Council, working with various community groups and archaeological consultants, has been collecting graveyard memorial data for a number of years.
- Until recently this data has been collected through several methods, both paper-based and semi-digital
 making it difficult to integrate, access, and share.
- In 2020 the Council's Heritage and Geographical Information Systems (GIS) sections carried out a review with objectives of streamlining, standardising, and simplifying the survey process with the ultimate aim of generating a digital dataset that could be made freely available.
- In 2022 a project was initiated, supported by 'Heritage Council' and 'Open Data Engagement' funding, to build and implement a cloud based digital solution consisting of various innovative components.
- Solution is now successfully in place and to date over 25,000 memorials have been surveyed and validated and available through a publicly accessible web based application.
- Winner 2023 Best Community Engagement Award at recent Public Sector Digital Transformation Award.















Key Objectives



- 1. Record memorial and burial details in a standardised way.
- 2. Reduce survey to publication timeframe.
- **3. Collate and consolidate** all historical survey data with new survey data in a single system.
- 4. Increase access to memorial and burial data.
- 5. Share data under an **open licence** for 3rd party use.
- 6. Utilise a technical architecture that **supports the future expansion** of the solution as a shared service offering.
- 7. Secure valuable data for future reference purposes.

- Built to Share: Solution can be shared with other Local Authorities.









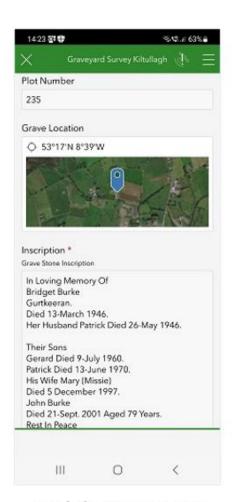


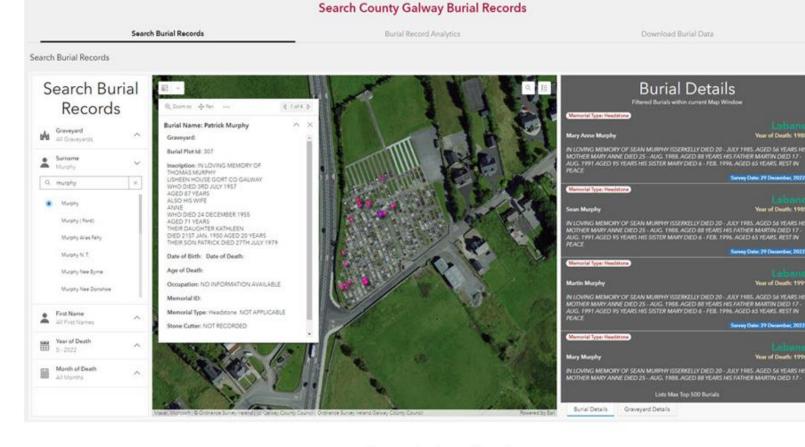












Mobile Survey App

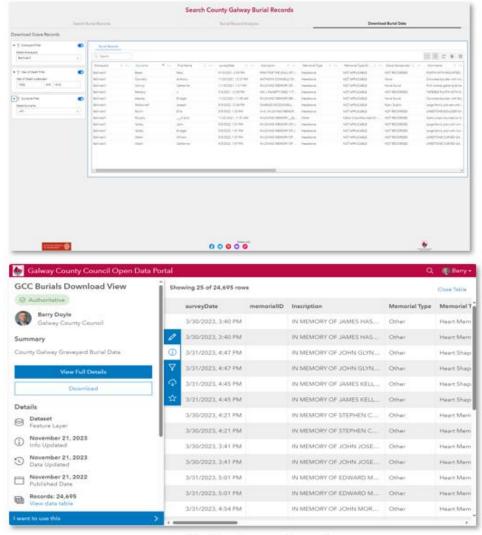
