




Open Data Maturity report 2018



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
Weighted averages

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How we measured impact

Indicator	Key elements
Strategic awareness	 An approach and methodology are in place to ensure sustained monitoring and measurement of Open Data reuse and impact
Political	 Various reuse examples can be provided and reuse in the field is systematically monitored
Social	 Various reuse examples can be provided and reuse in the field is systematically monitored
Environmental	 Various reuse examples can be provided and reuse in the field is systematically monitored
Economic	 Various studies that focus on the impact at micro and macro- levels, as well as the sectoral impact of Open Data are conducted in the country

What's next for the trend-setters?



- Enhance and consolidate your Open Data ecosystem. Enable the development of 'thematic data ecosystems' around high-value data or high-priority domains.
- Steer the network of Open Data stewards towards activities to enable data-driven policy-making. Decentralise monitoring activities to the network of Open Data stewards within your country.
- 3
- **Define a strategy to ensure the portal's sustainability.** Experiment with alternative funding models.
- Engage universities and research institutions to develop countryspecific metrics to measure impact. Define and understand clearly the 'impact' to be measured, in a way that is relevant to the area being measured. Do not be afraid to try and fail.
