

Item	Impact						
What to call it	Quite simply: Exit (Eireann wit)



# The Future of Open Data

- The arrival of Quantum Computing should be positioned for now
- Open Data management should be included in all second and third level business and economics curricula
- The open data portal should include more scenario support data sets
