### **History of Dublinked**

OCT 2011

Dublinked Open Data Portal and Innovation Network was launched in partnership with IBM and Maynooth University.

MAR 2016 Dublinked, under the umbrella of the Smart Dublin initiative, was re-launched. The proprietary IBM portal was replaced with CKAN platform.

JUN 2017 The decision was made to fully integrate the Dublinked portal as part of the Smart Dublin website.

**SEPT 2017** 

A tender for the integration and procurement of a managed service was issued through eTenders. Derilinx were successful and awarded this contract.

JAN 2018 The newly integrated Dublinked Open Data Store went live on Smart Dublin's website.

MID 2018 Reviews and assessments of data platform and storage architecture were conducted alongside an audit of currently available datasets

MAR 2019 Dublinked Data Strategy 2019 approved by the four Dublin Chief Executives to drive data initiatives across the Dublin region commences.






# HEATMAP OF CENTRAL DUBLIN

1500 cyclists apply




